Prerequisite(s): Completion of Planning 10 required and the student must be at least 15 years of age or older. The majority of this course and most of the work placements take place outside of the regular school timetable. Students who are interested in this course **must** be highly self-motivated, responsible, extremely organized and dependable. Students should be available to work (at least twice a week for a minimum of 8 hours total per week) as students must complete 90 hours at their placement in order to meet the course requirements. Having access to transportation is essential as students are responsible for getting to and from their placements on time. As part of the course, students are responsible for taking the initiative to locate a placement for themselves that meets the requirements of their focus area. Students will not be permitted to start their placements until approximately 20 hours of mandatory classroom instruction takes place and all preparatory assignments are completed. Please note that while we will do our best to assist students in their search for employers in their field of interest, it may not always be possible. Due to confidentiality and legal issues, placements in accounting, law, nursing and counselling are extremely difficult to source. Most work placements are unpaid. Students wishing to enroll in this course should have a genuine interest in representing RE Mountain in the community and be open and willing to learn new things.
