## ADMISSIONS

### UFV: OPEN October 1, 2019

January 1, 2020 is the application deadline for Fall Semester (September).

### UBC: OPEN September 2019

January 15, 2020 is the deadline to apply for the Winter Session (September 2020 to April 2021).

Important: If you are interested in applying to the Sauder School of Business (BCom) you will need to submit a VIDEO interview as part of your application. The upcoming UBC Admissions workshop or PSI day will be a very good opportunity to learn more.

### U of TORONTO: OPEN September 2019

January 15, 2020 is the application deadline for all applicants on OUAC, unless extended. Details will be posted on this page throughout the year.

### SFU: OPEN October 1, 2019

January 31, 2020 is the deadline to apply for admission for Fall 2020 (September).

### UVIC:

February 28, 2020 is the application deadline to apply for Canadian high school applicants.

### KPU: OPEN October 1, 2019

March 1, 2020 is the application deadline for limited and open (early admission) intake programs.

### U of ALBERTA: OPEN October 1, 2019

March 1, 2020 is the application deadline for most direct-entry programs on Apply Alberta.

### TWU:

March 1, 2020 is the early application deadline for Canadian high school applicants

### BCIT: OPEN September 2019

Most full-time technology programs application deadline is April 17, 2020. They begin processing November 1, 2019 until each program fills.

## TD SCHOLARSHIP FOR COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP

Deadline: November 15, 2019

Value: up to \$70,000

TD Scholarships for Community Leadership is one of the largest and most prestigious scholarship programs in Canada.

Last year, out of 25000 applications, 20 students were awarded full scholarships, valued at up to \$70,000 each. These scholarships are awarded to students across Canada who have shown exceptional initiative in making a meaningful and lasting difference in their community.

Each scholarship includes four years of tuition at any approved university or college in Canada, up to a maximum of \$10,000 per year; \$7,500 per year towards living expenses; and offers of summer employment. Apply online at [www.TD.com](http://www.TD.com)

## UBC CENTENNIAL SCHOLARS AWARD

Deadline: December 1

Value: up to \$80,000

The Major Entrance Scholarship program recognizes exceptional students for their academic and non-academic achievements with awards of up to \$60,000. Students who apply will receive automatic consideration.

The Centennial Scholars Entrance Award is designed to improve access to post-secondary education for exceptional students facing significant financial barriers. This award is valued up to \$80,000 and requires a separate application.

A number of Major Entrance Scholarships and Centennial Scholars Entrance Awards are designated specifically for Aboriginal students. Applicants can self-identify as Aboriginal in their application to UBC.
