Langley DPAC Educational Award in Trades

Langley District Parent Advisory Council will award two \$500 scholarships to this years successful applicants.

Langley DPAC established the Langley DPAC Educational Award in Trades in 2021 in response to parent input recognizing the importance of various trades available to our graduates.

The successful applicant will demonstrate either visually or through written work why the trades are important and how they have contributed to their learning.

The work submitted will vary from applicant to applicant but as a general guideline it should not exceed two written pages, a maximum 5 minute visual presentation or a slideshow up to 15 slides. These are general guidelines and it is up to the applicant on how they wish to show the value of their chosen trade.

Idea: You may refer to past or present experience, personal experience or observation. It can include community resources, importance of encouraging other students to pursue the trades or just a personal experience. No research needed – present from the heart.

The Langley DPAC Educational Aware in Trades was established from the school community who felt it important to include and encourage further learning in the trades. Our PAC and DPAC community understand that students take various paths to further education and that the various and varied trades are an important and integral component to our communities at large.

We want to recognize the value of trades as well as encourage fellow students of the options they have in pursuing further education.

CRITERIA

The award will be granted annually to two students attending a public school in Langley. The following must be submitted:

- 1) A completed Langley DPAC Educational Award in Trades application form showing specific plans for immediate secondary, post-secondary academic, technical or vocational education or training.
- 2) Written confirmation from your school principal or counselor on school letterhead that you are or will be enrolled in a trade curriculum currently or in the next Academic year.
- 3) A presentation of the applicants choosing that represents their chosen trade.
- 4) Students attending a school in the Langley School District are eligible to apply.
- 5) The applicant must agree to have their name published in a newspaper, on a website, PAC, BCCPAC or DPAC publications.

For the 2020/2021 school year, an award in the amount of \$500 will be given to two students entering or involved in **ANY APPLICABLE TRADE PROGRAM.** Please submit your essay via email ONLY to: scholarship@langleydpac.ca
