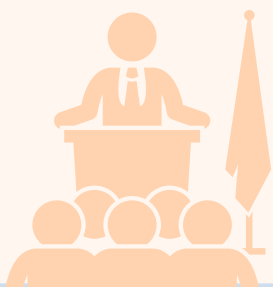

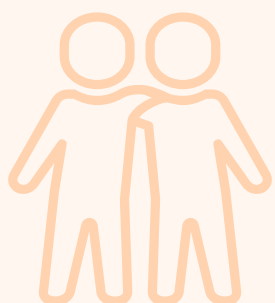

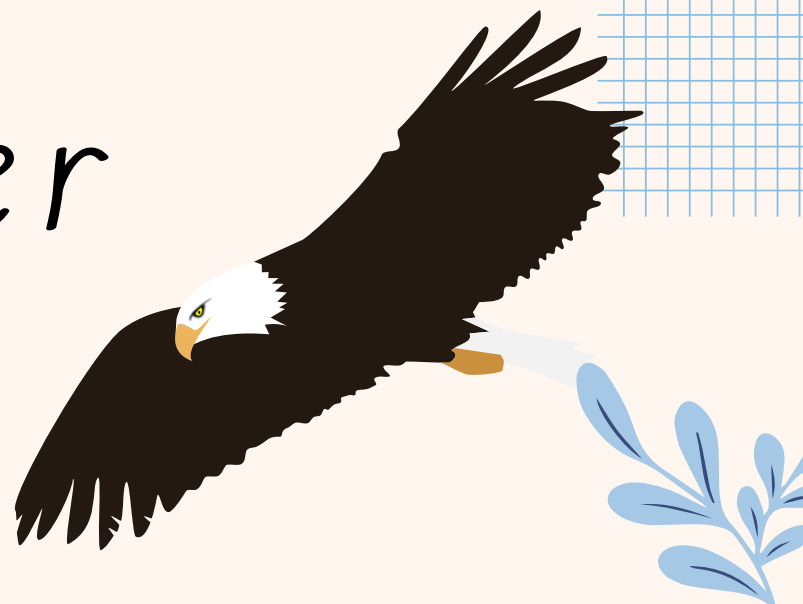


Table Tennis Club

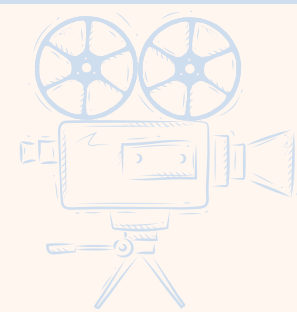

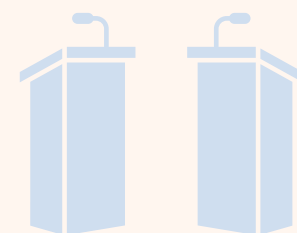
Auto Shop - Mr. Ekkert - Afterschool ending time can vary sometimes.

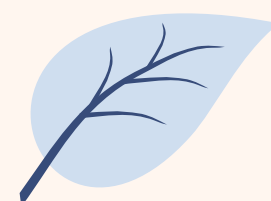

Student Empowerment Club

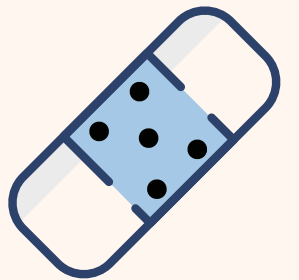

Guitar Club

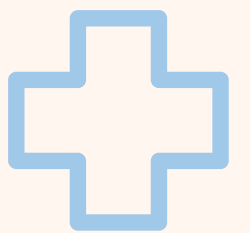

Cover Band

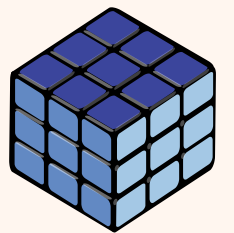
Room 2020 - Mr. Mills - Friday After School

Room 1111 - Mr. Duliba - Mondays at Lunch

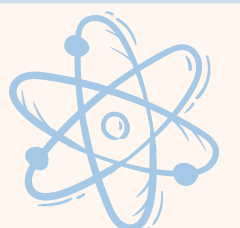

Physics Club

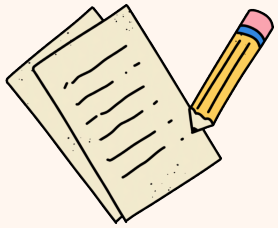

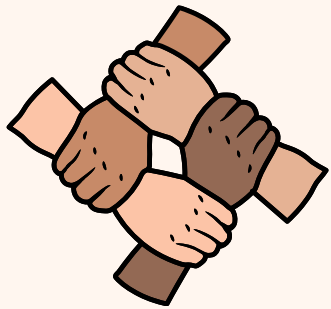
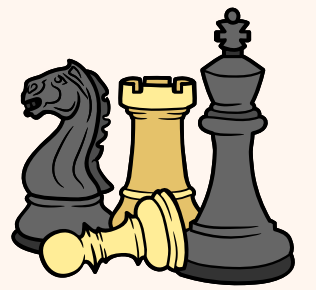

Hands in Harmony

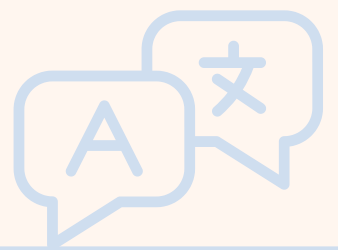
